

Attorneys Recommended to Practice Law in Wyoming

The Board of Law Examiners met in April 2015 and is recommending Emily Norma T. Each applicant for admission to practice law in Wyoming is required to satisfactorily complete the application process. After the Board of Law Examiners determines the applicant meets the necessary requirements, a recommendation for admission is forwarded to the Supreme Court. Admission is complete upon the filing of the Oath of Attorney in the Supreme Court.

In October, 2014 the Board of Law Examiners began reviewing Uniform Bar Score Transfer and Motion applications on a monthly basis. The administration of the Uniform Bar Examination takes place in February and July of each year. Some of the above names sat and passed the Uniform Bar Examination administered in February 2015.
